Four Cycle Engine

A cycle is one half revolution or 180° travel of the flywheels. The flywheels must make two complete revolutions to complete one power impulse of the motor per cylinder, therefore the term 'four cycle' is a sum of the cycles it takes to run 2 cylinders through a full power impulse. ¹²⁾
