### Front Fork Fluid Availability

WP Suspension Fluid 7.5 wt. is the only replacement fluid recommended for use in the Buell motorcycle front suspension.

#### Muffler Clamp Torque

The exhaust pipe/muffler clamp is the same TORCA clamp, part number 65299-94Y, used on late model Harley-Davidsons. This clamp has a one time usage and should be replaced each time it has been removed. The installation torque is 45-60 ft.-lbs (61-80 Nm).


#### **Teflon Wear Pads**

A teflon wear pad, part number, 47930-96Y, is now available to prevent scuffing of the rear fender on the frame tube.



#### **Ignition Timing- 1996 Models**

All 1996 Buell motorcycles should have the ignition timing checked with the vehicle **AT IDLE** (950-1050 rpm) <u>not</u> at 1650-1950 rpm as with earlier models. The timing mark that should be visible will be a "lazy 8" or a pair of side-by-side drilled dots.



Incorrect ignition timing could result in a loss of performance or even severe engine damage Ignition timing procedures are outlined in the 1996 Buell Predelivery & Setup Manual and the 1995-1996 Buell Service Manual.

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#### **NEW PARTS**

#### **Longer Seat Lock Tang**

An increased length seat tang is now in production. This change went into production starting with vehicle VIN: 49 state: **1293**. The part number is 52197-94Y.




#### Front Fender Change

Beginning with VIN: 49 state: **1337**, Calif.: **052** the front fender has been changed to eliminate the two plastic clips used to retain the speedometer cable. A wire form, attached to the front fork, now serves this purpose. Replacement fenders will not have the holes for the old style clips so you must update.

The part numbers to do this are:


Screw	67369-95Y

#### **D-Washer Change**

Beginning with vehicle VIN: 49 state: **1242**, the top engine mount D-washer is now beveled to prevent contact with the steering neck tube.

Protective pads, p.n. 16768-96Y (white for S2) or p.n. 16767-96Y (gray for S2-T) are available for vehicles with earlier style washers. This pad is installed on the back of the neck tube to prevent contact with the painted surface.
