Warm Weather Riding Comfort

As mentioned in the Touring Models Owner's Manual:

Under some conditions rider comfort may be improved by removing the fairing mounted air deflectors to allow more air movement behind the fairing.

Additionally, as shown in the January New Product release and the spring supplements there are some new products to be aware of:

Adjustable Air Deflector kit part # **57804-07**

Mid-Frame Air Deflectors part # 58022-07

Rider comfort may also be improved by opening the lower fairing vent, or in some cases removing the lower fairings for the season or the trip.
