Models

This kit fits is designed for installation of a low suspension kit on the 1987 XLH SPORTSTER® 883 HUGGER model, and on all 1988 and later XLH SPORTSTER® models.

Additional Parts Required

A WARNING

Rider and passenger safety depend upon the correct installation of this kit. Use the appropriate service manual procedures. If the procedure is not within your capabilities or you do not have the correct tools, have a Harley-Davidson dealer perform the installation. This instruction sheet references Service Manual information. A Service Manual for your model motorcycle is available from a Harley-Davidson Dealer.


Kit Contents

See Figure 3 and Table 1.

The rear fork assembly in this kit is the same design as the original equipment rear fork used on late 1994 XLH Sportster models.

INSTALLATION

- 1. Remove original rear fork assembly according to appropriate Service Manual procedures. Discard original chain/belt guard front mounting fasteners and original rear fork assembly only; save all other original components and fasteners, which will be reused when installing new rear fork assembly.
- Install new rear fork assembly (from kit) according to the appropriate Service Manual procedures and the following special instructions:



- Rubber isolator pad
- Chain quard rear mounting bracket

Figure 1. Rubber Isolator Pad - Installed

See Figure 1. On chain drive models prior to 1991 model year only, rubber isolator pad (1) (from kit) will need to be attached to original chain guard before chain guard is installed onto motorcycle. Thoroughly clean outboard surface of chain guard rear mounting bracket (2) (specifically, the section of the bracket which guards upper front quarter of rear chain sprocket), removing any dirt, grease, or oil. Remove the release paper from adhesive-backed rubber isolator pad. Position and attach adhesive side of pad to chain guard rear mounting bracket, as shown, such that entire outboard surface of pad will bear against inboard surface of rear fork assembly (3) when chain guard is installed.

NOTE

1991 and later XLH Sportster models already have one of two different styles of original equipment rubber isolator pads installed on the chain/belt quard rear mounting bracket; these particular models will not require installation of the pad in this




Figure 2. Guard Installation

· See Figure 2. On all models, install chain/belt guard (1) to rear fork assembly (2) such that front mounting bracket of chain/belt guard is positioned against inboard side of front mounting tab on rear fork assembly. Insert hex head bolt with flat washer (both supplied in this kit) through holes in front mounting tab on rear fork assembly and front mounting bracket of chain/belt guard. Install locknut (from kit) on end of bolt; tighten locknut to 19 ft-lbs.




Figure 3. Service Parts: Rear Fork Kit
