SPORTSTER CHROME SPROCKET COVER KIT

General

This kit is designed for installation on 1996 to 2003 XL (Sportster®) models.


Kit contents:

Qty Description 1 Sprocket cover

1 1/4-20 x 2 inch long screw
1 1/4-20 x 2-1/2 inch long screw

Installation

- Remove the two screws that hold the rear master cylinder in place on the existing sprocket cover.
- 2. Remove heat shield from rear exhaust pipe.
- 3. Remove rear muffler mounting screw from muffler support.
- Loosen rear exhaust pipe from cylinder head exhaust studs. Note: It is not necessary to entirely remove rear exhaust pipe and muffler from motorcycle.
- Remove rear brake line P-clamp from the existing sprocket cover.
- Remove the two upper screws from the existing sprocket cover (see illustration). Do not remove the existing cover.
- Place the chrome sprocket cover over the existing sprocket cover and install the two buttonhead screws from kit (see illustration). Tighten buttonhead screws to 90-110 in-lbs (10.2-12.4 Nm).



Chrome Sprocket Cover

- Reinstall rear muffler to muffler support. Do not tighten yet.
- Tighten nuts at cylinder head exhaust studs to 6-8 ft-lbs (8-11 Nm). Tighten nut at muffler support to 10-15 ft-lbs (14-20 Nm).
- Reinstall rear master cylinder mounting screws and tighten to 155-190 in-lbs (17.5-21.5 Nm). Reattach rear brake line clamp.
- 11. Reinstall heat shield to rear exhaust pipe.
